Are you ready for the first eLearning day?

What devices can be used to complete eLearning lessons?

- Chromebooks
- Tablets (iPads, etc.)
- Laptops
- Desktop computers
- Smart phones (less ideal because of screen size)

How can students be sure to complete lessons on time?

- Students have three days following each snow day to get a grade and be marked as present.
- If WiFi is not available at home, and if traveling somewhere with free WiFi is unsafe the day of school closure, students may visit one of the Saint Joseph County public libraries. Want to find one nearby? Go to <https://sjcpl.lib.in.us/locations>.
- Each lesson should take about 20 minutes for elementary and middle school students. High school lessons are about 30 minutes each.

What if my student needs assistance during the eLearning day?

Teachers will be available via email during the same hours they would be in school. Remember, they might be helping a few students at a time, so be patient and try to write questions clearly. While you wait, go ahead and begin working on the next assignment!

You may have read that usernames need a last name. They do not.

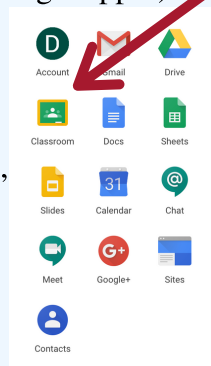
Follow these steps to log in for eLearning:

- 1.) Log out of any other Google accounts on the device.
- 2.) Go to "classroom.google.com"
(via the nine dots at the upper right hand corner, "Google apps")
- 3.) Enter student's username.
firstnameID@students.sbcsk.k12.in.us
- 4.) Enter student's password. (student's password is made of their first name, all lowercase, and their date of birth as MMDDYYYY.
